Dispatch of Vaccination Vouchers and Reservation Method Starting in Spring 2023

Who Will Receive the Voucher?

Those who have had an Omicron-targeting booster shot AND are

- a) 60 years old or older
- b) 5-59 years old and can be verified by the city to have underlying diseases or to have applied as a healthcare worker at the time of the fourth vaccination.

* Those aged 60-64 are only eligible if they fall under (2) or (3) above.

When Does the Dispatch Start?

Vouchers will be sent out in order from May 22 (Mon.).

Vouchers for those vaccinated within the last three months will be sent approximately three months after the date of vaccination.

If the voucher does not arrive, those falling under (2), (3), or (4) above can apply electronically via “e-kotonara”, the joint portal site of local governments in Nara Prefecture. Applications are also accepted by calling the call center shown below, over the counter, or by postal mail.

How to Make a Reservation for Individual Vaccinations at Medical Facilities.

Reservations start at 11:00 on May 25 (Thurs.). To avoid congestion, start dates vary according to the age of the recipient. (Both reservations and vaccinations are open to those aged 5-11 years on all dates.)

* Mass vaccinations are not planned for this fiscal year.

We continue to provide vaccinations for infants and children,

Infants and children aged 6 months to 4 years old can get a vaccine.
Children aged 5 and older can get the primary (1st and 2nd) vaccines.

You can make a reservation for the vaccination above at each medical institution, via city website or City Call Center. Please check the Nara City website for detail.

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) will be reclassified as a category 5 (five) infectious disease, starting on May 8 (Mon.).

*This information is as of April 7 (Fri.) 2023, and is subject to change.

After being reclassified, the counter measures against COVID -19 will be changed. The following four measures will end May 7 (Sun.)

- 1, Registration Center for people testing positive
- 2, Rental of pulse oximeters
- 3, Daily announcement of number of people infected
- 4, Publication of monitoring indicators, such as hospital bed utilization, etc.

Daytime examinations on weekdays at City Holiday & Night Emergency Clinic for Fever Outpatients will end May 8 (Mon.).

Examinations on weekends and holidays will continue as usual for the time being.

Preliminary Examination Leaflets for Vaccinations Were Sent out in Late April for Those Born in March 2023.

In order to have your baby vaccinated, the preliminary examination leaflets, Mother's and Child's Health Handbook and health insurance card are required on the day of vaccination. Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for those born in May 2020)

Those Eligible: From age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday

Method: The first two vaccinations are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second shot.

Things to bring: Preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, and your child's ID document.

* Those who are not registered as a citizen of Nara City are not eligible.

Fee: 1,500 yen. (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only)
600 yen as an additional fee for a sputum test based on the general check-up for lung cancer. (Postage might need to be paid.)

Those eligible: 40 years of age or older. Pregnant women, those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment, those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible), and those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible) are excluded.

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health condition and questionnaire.

Vaccination Against Mumps

Swelling of the parotid gland, pain, and fever are main symptoms of mumps. In rare cases mumps may cause sensory-neural hearing loss. We have no effective means to cure it. It is very important to get a vaccination. Please consider vaccinating your child against mumps. Nara City will bear a part of the vaccination fee.

Caution!

Mumps vaccination is voluntary. Guardians must understand its purpose and side-effects. And please decide if you should let your child get it or not.

Eligibility: For those who have a residence certificate in Nara City on the day and who are from one year of age until one day before two years of age. Those who had mumps are excluded. We cannot refund the fee if your child has been vaccinated already.

Subsidies: 3,000 yen

This will be taken off the fee owed to the facility.

Place: The registered medical facilities listed on the city website. You cannot receive the subsidy if you get another facility.

Children's Regular Vaccination Schedule for Fiscal Year 2023

Eligibility: For those who have a certificate of residence in Nara City when you apply.

Place: Medical institutions registered with Nara City (Please refer to the Nara City Website)

Things to bring: *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, health insurance card identifying the child as a resident of Nara City, and preliminary examination leaflet

*The leaflets for those who get preferential measures for Japanese Encephalitis and the 2nd Term; 2-type Combination Vaccination for Diphtheria and Tetanus; and Human Papilloma Virus vaccine are available at the medical institutions.
