Wishing for a Happy City for Both People and Cats

Cats that have been neutered by the Animal Conservation Volunteer Group are called "Sakura cats" because the notches cut in their ears resemble cherry blossoms.

Dogs and cats are protected by public health centers for various reasons. In particular, there are many stray cats about ten times as many as dogs. Nara City is focusing on finding the owners of these cats. In addition, recently, we have been working to support TNR (trap, neuter, release) activities to neuter cats without owners, and to reduce the number of cats without owners.

An increasing number of transfer circles and zero culling

Locally protected dogs and cats are transferred as much as possible. In the first year of Reiwa (2019) and the second year (2020), we achieved zero culling for the second consecutive year.

Nara City's Personnel Administration

Nara City has the aim of "Appropriate staff, system, and duties". We have been implementing appropriate placement and adoption of the staff, reduction of labor costs, and so on. We wish to inform you about the number of staff and salary, mainly in F.Y. 2020, based on "Nara City's ordinance concerning the publication of personnel administration."

We have achieved the target point of staff reduction.

We have employed experienced persons and coped with administrative problems becoming more complicated. The ratio of women in management has reached its maximum, 33.8 percent.

The number of male staff who took parental leave has increased.

We are making efforts to review "the number of staff, the system, and the duties" to reduce labor costs.

About Booster Shots (the 3rd Shots)

The Nara City will send a notice for the 3rd vaccination shot to those who received their 2nd vaccination eight or more months ago. In order to get it, please ask for advice from your family doctor after receiving the notice. More details will be in the January 2022 issue of the Nara City Information.

When the 3rd vaccination tickets (a vaccination ticket and a medical interview sheet combined) will be sent: For medical workers who were vaccinated by the end of April, 2021 to be sent within December 2021.

For those other than the above to be sent in order starting from those who received the 2nd vaccination eight or more months ago.

About the First and the Second Shots

Percentage of vaccination in Nara City

More than 75% of those were given both shots, and more than 80% of them finished the 1st one as of October 28. This ratio exceeds our initial target of 70%. We appreciate your cooperation.

For those who have not been vaccinated twice, please visit medical facilities by yourself.

You can receive the 1st and 2nd vaccinations at medical facilities designated by the city. Please make a booking by phone or internet.

Please be aware that the call center will be closed during the new year and year-end holidays.



There are many opportunities to dine together or to gather with relatives during the year-end and New Year holidays. For relatives who don't live together, please avoid sharing dishes and chopsticks while eating.

Garbage Collection

Unburnable Garbage may be disposed of without being disassembled

Disassembled unburnable garbage cannot be collected. Intact garbage may only be disposed of in one transparent/semi-transparent 45-liter or less plastic bag. Garbage which does not fit in a 45-liter bag can be collected as "Bulky Garbage", or must be brought in. For details, please look at the Nara City website (in Japanese only).

Preliminary Examination Leaflets Were Sent in Late November (to those born in October 2021)

If you bring the preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, and Health Insurance Card or other ID, you can receive vaccinations. If you have not received the preliminary examination leaflet due to moving into the city, etc. call Kenko Zoshin-Ka (Health Care Section). Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (For Those Born in December 2018) We recommend that your child receives the first term vaccination (the first two times, and a one-time booster). Please confirm their vaccination status on the preliminary examination leaflet. Those Eligible: Between age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday.

Vaccination Method: The first vaccination are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second.

Things to Bring: Pre-examination sheets (please fill in with an indelible black pen), Mother's and Child's

Health Handbook and your child's ID document.

*Those who are not registered as residents of Nara City are not eligible.

- **Fee**: 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only). Based on a general check-up for lung cancer, an additional fee of 600 yen might be needed for sputum examination. (Postage might need to be paid).
- **Those Eligible**: 40 years old and over except for: pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had an endoscopy for stomach cancer by Nara City in the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible)
