The number of tourists to Nara City has been recovering, and is expected to recover to approximately 90 percent of the FY 2019 level in FY 2024. As for foreign tourists, a relatively large number of them are coming from Western countries, and they tend to stay in Nara for a longer period of time.

While the Nara Park area is the most popular, the Nishi-no-Kyo area with Yakushiji Temple and Toshodaiji Temple is gaining more visitors to some extent. Many foreign tourists have become interested not only in shopping and Japanese food, but also in admiring beautiful nature, strolling downtown, and experiencing Japanese history and traditional culture.

- 1) Stay away from the hive
- 2) Do not provoke the hive unnecessarily
- 3) When pruning garden trees, be careful to see if there isn't a hive

Nara City does not exterminate hives at private properties. Landowners need to contact a professional company for extermination. For consultation, contact Nara Pest Control Association (Tel. 0742-23-7312)

If You Are Stung

- 1) Squeeze the venom out of the wound strongly and be sure to remove the stinger
- 2) Wash the wound with running water
- 3) Cool the wound such as with ice
- 4) Consult a doctor. If you feel something wrong with your body, have a medical examination immediately.

August is Food Hygiene Month

Precautions against Food Poisoning Caused by Campylobacter and Internal Bleeding Coli such as 0157

- 1) Don't eat raw meat or undercooked meat.
- 2) Use different tongs or chopsticks for cooking and eating.
- 3) Use different knives and cutting boards for meat, and do not let meat drip onto other food.

Pay Attention to Fish Parasites such as Anisakis

- 1) They often live in mackerel, horse mackerel, bonito, squid, flounder, etc.
- 2) Choose fresh fish and remove entrails quickly.
- 3) Freeze or heat fish sufficiently.

Three Important Rules for Preventing Food Poisoning

- 1 Don't spread germs: Wash your hands often. Thoroughly wash cooking utensils.
- **2 Don't let germs multiply**: Put purchased food in the refrigerator or freezer immediately. Eat cooked food quickly.
- **3 Sterilize**: Heat the inside of food to 75 degrees Celsius or over for more than one minute.

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please inform us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases where you may not be able to have the examination depending on your physical condition or medical consultation on that day.
