Let's Start Reducing Waste

Why Waste Reduction Is Needed Now

- 1) to reduce the burden on the environment
- 2) to maintain the current incinerators
- 3) to lower waste disposal costs

Waste reduction eases the burden on the environment and incinerators while improving the quality of other public services.

Turn "Miscellaneous Paper" into Resources!

Approximately 20% of burnable garbage consists of newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and other recyclable paper items known as "miscellaneous paper". Collecting and recycling this paper together turns it into a renewable resource and significantly reduces waste.

Note:

- 1) Miscellaneous paper collection boxes have been installed at 31 locations throughout Nara City, including the City Hall, Shutcho-sho (branch offices of the City Hall), and administrative centers.
- 2) The following items are not considered "miscellaneous paper":
 - photographs
 - photo printing paper
 - laminated postcards
 - paper stuffed inside shoes or bags
 - waterproof items like paper cups
- 3) Paper with odors, such as soap boxes, or stained with food or oil cannot be disposed of as "miscellaneous paper".

How to protect your family during a disaster

3 steps when an earthquake strikes

1. Ensure objects won't fall or topple over.

Pruned branches should be cut into pieces less than 5cm in diameter and 30cm in length. Please apply to dispose of them using bulky household waste pickup, or as carry-in waste.

Please notify us in advance when you purchase or replace a refuse collection box

Depending on its shape and other factors, garbage may not be able to be collected easily or properly. Please be sure to contact us before buying and installing a new one. We would also like to ask you to cover all the costs.
