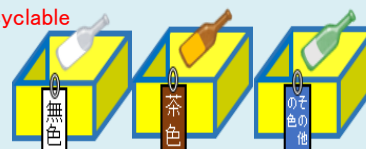

●How to put out recyclable resources

- Collection locations for recyclable resources may differ from those for burnable garbage.
- Please put them out at the designated collection location by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. Full containers may be collected first, but if you put your trash out AFTER 8:30 a.m., it may NOT be collected.
- Please rinse the inside of the container lightly before putting it out.
- Please separate the waste into mesh bags (for cans and plastic bottles), containers (for glass bottles) and containers with lids (for paper drink cartons) that the city will distribute the day before collection (excluding Saturdays and Sundays).
- Please remove labels and caps from plastic bottles and put them out on the "Plastic Packaging and Containers" day.
- Please separate glass bottles into three colors: "colorless," "brown," and "other colors." "Ceramic bottles should be disposed of as 'non-burnable waste,' not as 'recyclable resources.'"



*If the collection areas for recyclable resources and household waste area adjacent to each other, please be mindful of where you place them to ensure smooth pickup on overlapping days.
